- ✓ Pay TV (Foxtel, Netflix, etc.) – Update address or cancel subscriptions.



- ✓ Home Security System – Cancel, transfer, or update alarm monitoring services.
- ✓ Council Rates – Notify the council about your move.
- ✓ Postal Services – Set up mail redirection with Australia Post.
- ✓ Home & Contents Insurance – Update your policy to reflect your new address. (Car insurance to reflect new postcode, if relevant)

SUBSCRIPTIONS & MEMBERSHIPS:

- ✓ Gym Memberships – Cancel or transfer if moving out of area.
- ✓ Magazine & Newspaper Subscriptions – Update mailing address.
- ✓ Medical & Dental Providers – Notify them of your address change.
- ✓ Schools & Childcare – Inform institutions of your move if necessary.
- ✓ Banking & Financial Services – Update your residential address.

Utilities & Services:

- ✓ Electricity & Gas – Set up a new account or transfer services.
